Class structure:

United Way Kindergarten Jumpstart classes are arranged into four, 90 minute sessions. A parent or other adult helper is required to attend each session with the incoming kindergartener. Each session will focus on fun ways for you to help your child be ready for school. We will begin each class with a meal for you and your child, and you will leave each session with a new book and the tools for your child to practice their new skills at home.

Teachers:

Classes will be led by skilled, early childhood educators who will focus on helping you with the tools to teach your child critical kindergarten preparation skills in the weeks leading up to the first day of school.
