About United Way Leadership St. Joseph

United Way Leadership St. Joseph is an initiative of United Way of Greater St. Joseph. The mission of the initiative is to ***build the skills of individuals to be effective leaders in the community.***

Our graduates are recognized throughout the community as leaders in their organizations and the non-profit agencies for which they serve as volunteers and board members. Each year our participants gain knowledge about the critical issues facing our community and become part of a powerful network of leaders better positioned to influence and participate in developing a stronger community.

Program Curriculum

The United Way Leadership St. Joseph program curriculum is designed to help participants identify and maximize their leadership styles and increase their knowledge of the issues, needs and services available in our community. Participants are challenged by working in a small group to outline a project that helps meet a need in the community and by sharing a presentation about the project and their process in November.

Full participation and attendance are essential, not just for the benefit of the individual, but for the class as a whole. Each participant is selected because of the talents, skills, and knowledge he/she brings to the group.

Participation Selection Criteria

Each class is limited to a maximum of 28 participants. The selection committee works to select a class that reflects the diversity of the St. Joseph community. Selection is based on the following:

- Commitment, interest, and motivation to serving the community
- Desire to fulfill volunteer, board, or community leadership roles
- Ability to honor the time commitment required
- Residence and/or employment in the St. Joseph area
- Date application is received
- Diversity of class (employment, roles, gender, age, ethnicity, etc.)

Tuition

Tuition for the 2023 program is \$1,750. An invoice will be sent with the acceptance notification to those selected for participation. Tuition is non-refundable, may be paid following notification of acceptance and is due in full by February 1, 2023, unless other payment schedule arrangements have been made.

The attendance requirements have been established because of the value that each participant brings to the program. The program has been designed to bring together individuals of varying backgrounds, interests, and areas of expertise. Participants gain a wealth of community insight, information, and contacts through their classmates' full participation. **Because attendance is such a vital component of the program, participants and their employers must commit to fulfilling and supporting the fulfillment of the following requirements:**

Attendance at the monthly program sessions

Active participation in the group project and presentation. **The project development process generally involves outside-of-class meeting time as scheduled by each group.*

Understandably, emergency situations may occur that prevent a participant from attending a program session. Emergency situations will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

Employer and Applicant Commitment
