About United Way Leadership St. Joseph

United Way Leadership St. Joseph is an initiative of United Way of Greater St. Joseph. The mission of the initiative is to build the skills of individuals to be effective leaders in the community.

Our graduates are recognized throughout the community as leaders in their organizations and the non-profit agencies for which they serve as volunteers and board members. Each year our participants gain knowledge about the critical issues facing our community and become part of a powerful network of leaders, better positioned to influence and participate in developing a stronger community.

Program Curriculum

The United Way Leadership St. Joseph program curriculum is designed to help participants identify and maximize their leadership styles and increase their knowledge of the issues, needs, and services available in our community. Participants are challenged by working in a small group to outline a project that helps meet a need in the community and by sharing a presentation about the project and their process in November.

Full participation and attendance are essential, not just for the benefit of the individual, but for the class as a whole. Participant attendance and engagement allow class members to fully benefit from one another's talents, skills and knowledge.

Participation Criteria

Each class is limited to a maximum number of participants. United Way aims to create a class cohort that reflects the diversity of the St. Joseph community. Participants should:

- Express commitment, interest and motivation to serve the community.
- Desire to fulfill volunteer, board or community leadership roles.
- Have the ability to honor the time commitment required.
- Reside and/or work in the St. Joseph area.
- Apply by November 14, 2025.

Should applications exceed the maximum number of participants, a selection committee will review applications and select class participants.

Tuition

Tuition for the 2026 program is \$1,850. An invoice will be sent. Tuition is non-refundable, may be paid following notification of acceptance and is due in full by February 2, 2026, unless other payment schedule arrangements have been made.

The class will begin with an opening 2-day retreat on January 8-9, 2026, from 8:30 a.m.- 4:30 p.m. Thereafter, classes will be held from 8:30 a.m.- 4:30 p.m. on the second Thursday of each month (February - December).

Active participation in the group project and presentation. *The project development process generally involves outside-of-class meeting time as scheduled by each group.

Understandably, emergency situations may occur that prevent a participant from attending a program session. Emergency situations will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
