Community Missions (CMC) My Brother's House

- Population served: Homeless women & men in the St. Joseph area ages 18 and up.
- Shelter operates 24/7/365.
- No one is allowed in after 7 p.m. unless escorted by a professional.

The Salvation Army Booth Center

318 S. 6th Street; 816.232.5824

- Population served: Literally homeless families with at least one child under the age of 18 residing with them.
- Other information: Families needing shelter may call the office Monday-Friday 9:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m. to be placed on the waitlist.
- Sex offenders are not allowed in shelter.
